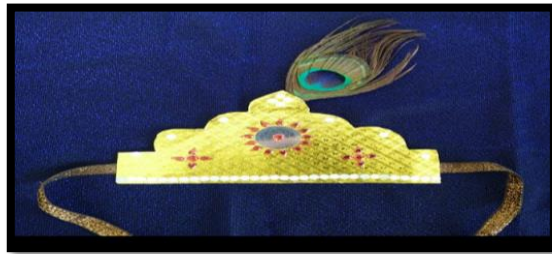
- **"TRICOLOUR FRUIT CHAAT MAKING"**: The purpose of this activity is to strengthen identification of fruits and a discussion on fruits as a yummy, healthy food. - **"MAKING PAPER MUKUT FOR KRISHNA"**: Mukut making activity will be organized to give the children essence of Janamashtmi. The students will be using decorating material like mirror, coloured beads, ribbons, stones, peacock feathers or bindis to decorate the mukut. **Parents are requested to send any of the decorative materials of their wards choice.**
