Q8. Who wrote the National Anthem of India?

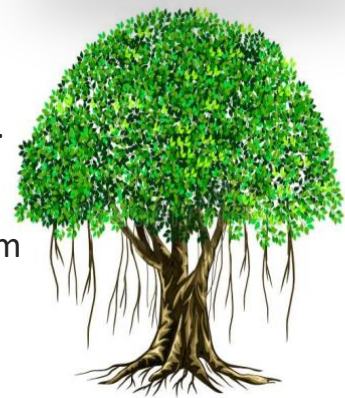
Ans. Rabindranath Tagore wrote the National Anthem of India.
