


Activity – 3

Take different coloured pulses from your MOM in different bowls. Then paste the pulses with fevicol to make this butterfly beautiful.




- Take two A3 size sheets. (1 any bright coloured and 1 white)

- Get the Sheet laminated and use it.









































MATERIALS REQUIRED

- 6. Make the robot's antennae using 2 matchsticks.







